Declaration

The World Intellectual Forum is a Global Think Tank involving intellectuals, scholars, scientists, public men and women and social animators to brainstorm periodically on issues of importance in international context and to bring out approach papers and provide policy inputs for development in the overall global context and for global peace, security and harmony.

The contemporary world peace and security is quite alarming. The Nuclear Holocaust and the Third World War seem to be imminent looking around the present world situation. The total number of ready-to-use nuclear warheads currently is plenty, but only a few of them are enough for the Mankind forever ceases to exist. Such countries as USA, Russia, France, China, UK, India, Pakistan, Israel and North Korea have the ability with the help of detonation of such bombs to destroy the whole humanity unless bound by constraint, compassion and human values and concerns.

The Global Summit – 2017 organised at Hyderabad, India by the World Intellectual Forum (WIF) with the main theme “Contemporary World Peace and Security and the Threat of Third World War” took note of the deteriorating conditions of the contemporary world peace and security and the imminent threat of third world war and made the following Declaration:

- 1. The current world system is based on the sovereignty of nation-states. The UN is ‘inter-national’, ‘between nation-states’, and has no authority or jurisdiction to end the wars. There have been 162 wars since 1945 on the planet which the UN has been unable to prevent or to end. Now the Syrian and North Korean Conflicts has the potential for escalating in to the Third World War. Therefore, there is ample scope for intellectual debate for evolving an innovative approach for an alternative*

World Government System with enforceable authority to restore peace, security and tranquility on the Globe and prevent the possibility of Third World War.

- 2. With regard to such a need for 'An Innovative System of Government' to overcome the deficiencies of the present system of World Governance, based on the discussions that took place at the Global Summit – 2017 on the Concept Paper presented on "Formation of New World Government – An Innovative Approach", it was agreed that the paper may be circulated widely to all reputed organizations and institutions working in the area of World Peace and Security and after obtaining their comments / suggestions a final draft should be prepared and circulated to the National Governments and the General Assembly of the United Nations.*
- 3. An appeal may be made to all the governments to cut down their military expenditure to a great extent and divert that amount to development programmes of the country concerned and also contribute a part of it to a "Global Pool" of Fund for development of the poor and towards their welfare right across the globe.*
- 4. To contribute towards world peace and security, the concept of a 'Global Council' on Religion, Culture and Human Future could also be tried.*
- 5. Efforts of Civil Societies like Earth Federation and Provisional World Parliament, Universal State of Earth, Supreme Council of Humanity (SCH), Universal Declaration on the Illegality of Wars on the Earth and Universal Declaration of Civil Transeducation of Earth inhabitants, the Earth Constitution and such other efforts are the Tools, Statements and Declarations born out of deep concern for the wellbeing of humanity on this globe. Mostly they are aiming at transformation of human mind and attitude through focusing on the gravity of world situation heading for a catastrophe of human annihilation on this globe, as Non-State Actors and Civil Societies contributing to 'Global Governance' and hence they should be appreciated and supported.*
- 6. The Global Summit-2017 noted the need for exploring new ideas and approaches for World Peace and Security and in this context the idea of "Passing From Passive Approach Avoiding War (survival mode) To a Proactive Approach (future creation mode) for Global Peace "expressed in a presentation on "Future Intelligence-A Path to Global Peace" made via Video conferencing at the Global Summit is worth exploring. Future intelligence is the human and social ability required to fashion and implement a desirable future, for humanity and all of biological diversity, and for the world.*

7. *Many organizations, agencies, institutions and university departments are working on peace studies and it would be a desirable idea to network them and establish a "Peace Ideas Bank". There is also need for formulating a "World Peace Policy".*
8. *The present youth are the future global citizens and leaders. They should be imbued with universal values and help develop proper frame of mind through value education and training so that when they become leaders positive outcomes will emerge for good governance and to build a peaceful society and obtain peaceful coexistence among nations and peace among peoples of the world.*
9. *The WIF Global Summit – 2017 urges the World National Governments to respect the recommendations of the various disarmament conventions, commissions and studies and the resolutions of the UN to stop the increase and spread of military arms for war and stop introduction of new technologies for more destructive weapons and not to acquire nuclear weapons towards achieving the aim of total disarmament.*
